How?

1. Club President or any club member can take the lead. We encourage new members to get involved!
2. Spread the word across the club and identify an eligible project
3. Submit entries via [THIS LINK](#) by midnight on April 10, 2026.
4. Finalists will be notified by April 30, 2026.
5. Finalists must present their project live on Saturday May 16, 2026, at the District Connect for Good Summit. Failure to participate will result in losing the contestants' place as a finalist.

One submission per club will be accepted. The project can be one that was completed in the current Rotary year, currently occurring or being planned for completion by April 30, 2027. District & Global Grant projects may be submitted, or it can be a separate project.

Why Participate?

- Be recognized for your unique project idea and sound project planning.
- Attract potential strategic partnerships in from other clubs.
- Showcase your project at the Summit and Gain exposure across the district.
- Opportunity to win a cash prize. There prizes for the finalists will be awarded for \$1,500, \$1,000 and \$500, contingent upon project completion.
- Inspire fellow Rotarians and make a lasting impact.
- **Everybody wins** – all qualified project submissions, with your club noted as contact, will be included in a reference project repository (available to all members) on our district website.
