

GLOBAL GRANT GUIDELINES

JULY 1, 2026– June 30, 2027

For Rotary Year 2026-2027, District 7475 guidelines for a club to qualify, apply and receive Global Grants are as follows:

1. **Rotary International Guidelines:** Global Grants must meet the requirements of [The Rotary Foundation Terms and Conditions for Rotary Foundation Global Grants](#) (February 2025 version). This document can also be found on the [Grants Information Webpage](#) on the [district website](#)
2. **Financial Standing:** *Prior to submitting a grant application*, the club must be in good standing relative to all Rotary financial obligations, including:
 - a. All Rotary International (RI) RY 2026-27 Member Dues and other assessments must be paid in full.
 - b. District 7475 RY 2026-27 Member Dues and PELS assessment must be paid in full.
 - c. All RI and District 7475 Member Dues and other assessments from prior Rotary years are paid in full.
 - d. All club commitments to The Rotary Foundation for RY 2025-26 must have been met.
3. **PELS:** Club President must have attended the 2026 PELS in *March 2026*.
4. **Qualification Seminar:** Two club officers (Club President and Club Rotary Foundation Chair or a club member designated by the President) must attend the virtual Grants Qualification Seminar on *June 23, 2026*.
5. **Giving Goals:** 2026-27 club Foundation giving goals (Annual Fund and PolioPlus) must be entered into Rotary Club Central *prior to starting an application*. The recommended club goals for Annual Giving and PolioPlus are \$100 and \$25, respectively, per member.
6. **Officers:** All RY 2026-27 club officers must be entered in ClubRunner *prior to starting an application*.
7. **RI Learning:** Three members of the club directly responsible for the Global Grant being applied for must complete the Grant Management courses in the [RI Learning Center](#) and provide the completion certificates to the District's Grants Committee Chair [Matt](#) *prior to starting an application*.
8. **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU):** The Club President and President-Elect must complete The Rotary Foundation Club Qualification MOU and submit to the District's Grants Committee Chair [Matt](#) *prior to starting an application*.
9. **Payment:** To receive payment for an approved Global Grant, all club RI and District dues and assessments must be paid in full.
