
What are the GOALS of working on your Club's *PUBLIC IMAGE*



ROTARY PUBLIC IMAGE Training



One of Rotary's strategic goals is to enhance the public's image of Rotary by increasing awareness of our service and activities. Rotary International has provided many tools for us to use in our day-to-day Rotary life. Those tools consist of guidelines, step-by-step instructions, templates, logos and much more.



What is the role of public image in Rotary?

When people understand what your club does to make the world a better place, they'll be motivated to support your efforts and get involved. Strengthening Rotary's public image in your community will help you attract members, volunteers,

partners, and donors.

DOES YOUR CLUB HAVE A PUBLIC IMAGE CHAIR?

What is the role of public image director in Rotary Club?

What a club public image chair does. The chair is responsible for designing flyers and posters, writing press releases, updating the website, managing the club's social media presence, and making sure the club logo is used properly and consistency.

Available resources to help you succeed

The Rotary Brand Center contains templates that are extremely helpful. I also recommend club public image chairs meet regularly with the district public image chair via digital networks or events to share ideas and strategize.

WHAT SOCIAL MEDIA PRESENCE DOES YOUR CLUB HAVE?


SOCIAL MEDIA

- Post content that is visually appealing and includes compelling statements about your club's activities.
- Share personal stories and news about club projects and events using the hashtag #PeopleofAction.
- Include quotes, photos, and videos from guest speakers (with their permission) and link to their social media pages.
- Keep your social media pages active by sharing content from Rotary International's channels or those of trusted partners.
- Encourage members to share your club's posts through their own social media accounts.
- Make sure your pages include up-to-date information and feature messages intended for the general public.

Rotary Club to honor 100 years with \$90K donation to Town

The Town of Morristown is excited to announce that it will host the Morristown Rotary Club for a donation ceremony at the Morristown Town Hall front steps on Wednesday, August 4, 2021 at 2pm.

The Rotary Club will sign over a very generous \$90,000 donation to the Town, to be put towards the purchase and installation of a new pavilion at Lidgerwood Park. The donation will be in celebration of the Club's centennial anniversary, first founded in 1922.

"We are very thankful for our Rotary Club," said Mayor Tim Dougherty. "With this wonderful donation, we will continue our work on revitalizing the local parks throughout the Town. Their \$90,000 donation will go directly towards a beautiful new pavilion at Lidgerwood Park."


The new 32' pavilion will stand approximately 12' tall, able to accommodate gatherings of friends and family for cool breaks from the harsh summer sun. It will sit beside the existing playground so parents will be able to watch their children play.

The Morristown Rotary Club, a volunteer organization, has served the Morristown community for nearly 100 years and is an active part of Rotary International. Morristown volunteers give their time to different community projects, raise funds, and provide support to many organizations that help our community members and students.



Some of their recent projects around the Morristown community include partnering and assisting with food donations to help the local homeless shelters and community, as well as the senior residents at the Town and Township Housing Authority buildings; running collection and distribution booths of books for children in need; assisting vets in transitional housing at the VA campus in Lyons every month; town beautification, the Table of Hope, town-wide clean-ups, soup kitchens, and even original music festivals.

"The Rotary Club is one of our most active community organizations here in Morristown," said Mayor Dougherty. "They keep our blood pumping and our town vibrant and colorful. We'll always appreciate them for the work they do and this donation is just the latest example."



A FaceBook PIXEL is a piece of computer code which is very easy to develop thru FaceBook.. and gets implanted in links to web pages, in Facebook links etc.. Apparently Very easily even by you.

When somebody clicks a link for more info, or interest link, etc..Like magic their contact info is YOURS..

How the Facebook pixel works


Once you've set up the Facebook pixel, the pixel will activate when someone takes an action on your website, including visiting your website. The pixel receives these actions, or events, which you can view on your Facebook pixel page in **Events Manager**. From there, you'll be able to see the actions that your constituents, voters or supporters take. You'll also have options to reach your community again through future Facebook ads by retargeting those who have interacted with your website.
