## PDG Victor P. K. Mensah

PDG Victor Paa Kwesi Mensah is a Chartered Manager, Teamologist, and a distinguished People and Organizational Development (POD) Consultant with extensive experience across Africa's public, multilateral, and development sectors. He is a Partner at *Victor & Victors MS Ltd.*, where he has advised governments, the African Union, United Nations agencies, and the African Development Bank on organizational systems, policy design, and strategic transformation initiatives.

A committed Pan-Africanist, Victor's professional work spans executive coaching, gender, youth development, and institutional strengthening. He has contributed to the development of National Youth Policies in multiple African countries and serves as a Gender in Education Policy Analyst with UNICEF. His work consistently focuses on building resilient institutions, empowering young people, and fostering intra-African collaboration.

In Rotary, Victor has demonstrated exceptional leadership and service since 2010 through the Rotary Club of Nkwazi in Zambia. He has served in numerous club roles, including Secretary, New Generations Chair, Public Image Director and Club President. He serves as Club Advisor to and a now Charter Member of the Rotary Pan-Africa ePassport Club, Chartered by RC Nkwazi in 2026. At the district, he served as District Registrar (DISCON), District Chair of Rotary Global Rewards, Assistant Governor, District Public Image Chair (DPIC), Chair of District Conference HOC, and District Administrator in various years. He culminated his district leadership journey as the #Changemaker District Governor of District 9210 (Zambia) in 2021–2022.

During his tenure as Governor, he led transformative initiatives and achieved a historic milestone—his district became the only one in Africa to attain 100% giving participation from all clubs to The Rotary Foundation, earning a special recognition. He is a Major Donor, Paul Harris Fellow, and member of the Paul Harris Society, and continues to champion a strong culture of giving and impact across Rotary.

At the regional and zone levels, Victor has served as Rotary Communications and Media Coordinator for Africa (2022–2024), Chair of the #RIConvention2Africa initiative, Assistant Regional Rotary Foundation Coordinator (ARRFC) for Region 28, and Chair of the Region 28 Governors' Council. Since 2024, he serves as the Rotary Zone 22 (Africa) Administrator, where he manages the Rotary International Director's Office and supports regional leadership—including Zone and Regional Coordinators and District Governors—to deliver on strategic priorities effectively. He played a significant global facilitation role as Co-Chair of Learning Seminars at the Fusion Summit 2025 in Brussels, the first-ever multi-zone institute spanning Europe, the Middle East, and Africa. In this capacity, he coordinated lead facilitators across 10 zones to deliver Governor-Elect Learning Seminars (GELS), Governor Nominee Learning Seminars (GNLS), and Partner sessions.

A prolific speaker and facilitator, Victor is known for his engaging style, strategic insight, and deep commitment to service. Despite his global footprint, he remains personable and grounded — “a fun but very shy person,” as he describes himself. He is married to Mina and is a proud father of three. He warmly encourages others to: *“Smile and call me Victor.”*
