

EVENT REGISTRATION

Registration Conditions

I indemnify Rotary, its officers and employees, agents and volunteers against all loss, damage, and expenses (including legal costs on a solicitor and own client basis) arising out of or in connection with any claims, actions, proceedings or demands of any kind arising directly or indirectly as a consequence of my participation in the Event. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the Event is because of my own free will and desire and that I have read and understood the above warning, release, and indemnity. I warrant that I am 18 years of age or older and am lawfully able to enter this above release and indemnity.

Medical Treatment Consent.

I give permission for the Conference Committee 2025 District 9815 to obtain emergency medical, hospital or ambulance assistance and/or treatment for me at any time they consider necessary. I acknowledge that I will be liable for any medical, hospital or ambulance expense incurred in my treatment, and I agree to pay those expenses.

Privacy Declaration.

I understand that Conference Committee 2025 District 9815 may collect information about me in accordance with their Privacy Policy and that this information may be disclosed to certain parties it engages to organise the Event. Up to 28 days before - Refund available 100%.

Up to 14 days before - 50% refund available.

Cancellations due to COVID-19

Any delegates who are unable to attend an Event due to reasons related to COVID-19 can apply for a refund, at the discretion of Conference Committee 2025 District 9815.

Transferring Registrations.

Unless stated otherwise, all Conference Committee 2025 District 9815 events allow registrations to be transferred to a new attendee. To transfer a registration, the new attendee needs to complete a new registration using a ticket code provided by Conference Committee 2025 District 9815.

While we understand that circumstances can change after registering for an event, these fees cover the administration required for cancellations and event costs already incurred.

Refund Processing.
