IPP Konrad talked about the history of the project, AFfC Trainer Kathi gave an overview of the program, Chief Education Officer Marcus Edwards delivered a message from the Government and Chess coordinator Daniel outlined his role in the chess project.

The declared goal is to expand the 1st. Move Chess program into every primary school in Saint Lucia as well as

establish after school chess clubs in secondary schools.
