**RESOLUTIONS APPROVED AT 2012 CONFERENCE**

**RESOLUTION #1 – DISTRICT GOVERNOR FOR 2014-2015**

---

Be it resolved that Rotarian Elwin Atmodimedjo from the Rotary Club of Paramaribo Residence in Suriname, be confirmed as District Governor for Rotary District 7030 for the 2014-2015 Rotary year.

**RESOLUTION #2 – INCREASE IN DISTRICT DUES**

---

Be it resolved that Rotary District 7030 annual District Dues be increased by US\$2 per Rotarian, to US\$ 27 per year, effective 1<sup>st</sup> July 2012. This shall allow for a US\$2 contribution per Rotarian to the District 7030 Disaster Relief Fund. The breakdown of annual District Dues will therefore be as follows:

US\$2 District Disaster Fund  
US\$20 District Governor travel and activities  
US\$5 Assistant Governor travel and activities  
US\$27 Total

District Dues are payable in full on the 1<sup>st</sup> July each year.

**RESOLUTION #3 – ADOPTION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

Be it resolved that the Financial Statements for the 2010-2011 Rotary year be approved and adopted by all Clubs in District 7030.



**RESOLUTION #4 – DISTRICT STRATEGIC PLAN**

Be it resolved that the Rotary District 7030 Strategic Plan for the period 2012-2014, enclosed herein (Appendix One), be approved and adopted by all Clubs of the District.

**RESOLUTION #5 – APPOINTMENT TO ZONE 34 DIRECTOR NOMINATING COMMITTEE**

Be it resolved that PDG Georges Nouh Chaia, of the Rotary Club of Cayenne, French Guiana, be confirmed as the District 7030 Representative on the 2012-2013 Zone 34 Nominating Committee for RI Director-Nominee. The alternate shall be PDG Anthony (Tony) Watkins of the Rotary Club of Barbados, Barbados.

**RESOLUTION #6 – JOHN WATTS AWARD**

Be it resolved that Rotary District 7030 adopt the proposal put forward by the Rotary Club of Grenada, at the 2011 District Conference in Barbados, for the introduction of two Awards named for PDG John Watts, the first Governor of our District:

1. Individual Award: In recognition of sterling contribution to the promotion of the ideals of Rotary
2. Club Award: US\$500 to be used on a project that distinctly promotes the ideals of Rotary
