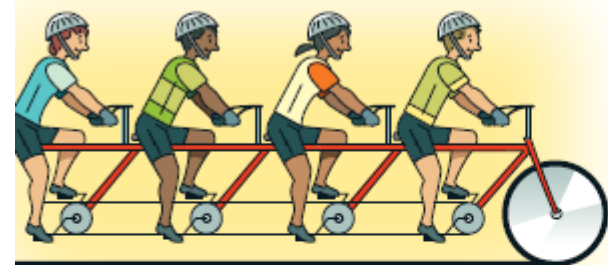

New York City and São Paulo have hosted the largest **Pride parades** in the world; each attracted about 5 million people in a single year.

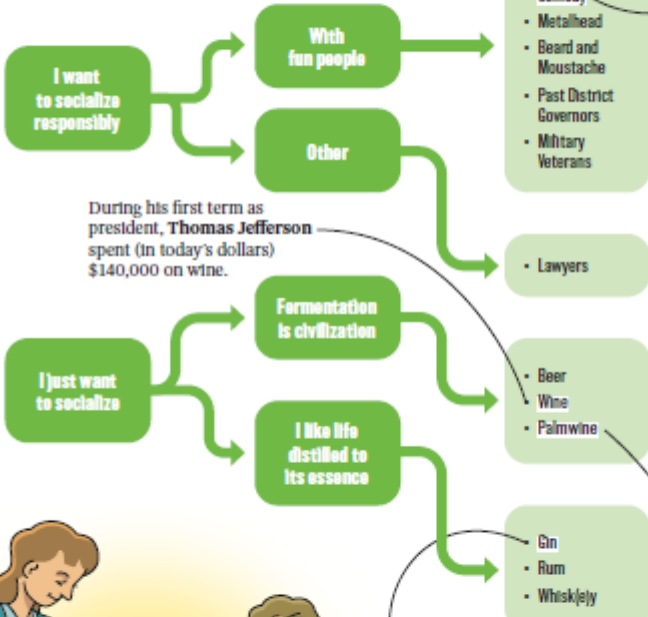
If 99 percent of Earth's population doesn't like you, that still means that for **79 million** people, you're their jam.
