The Rotary Club of St. Augustine was chartered as Rotary Club No. 94, on June 26, 1968. From our inception to date, we have provided extensive humanitarian and charitable services. The Club was incorporated by an Act of Parliament in April 1993 and we are a registered Charitable Organization.

Our club offers opportunities for our members — and those interested in making a difference — to get involved. Through meetings, social events, and volunteer projects, our members learn about the issues facing our community and communities all over the world, partnering with local, national, and global experts to exchange ideas about potential solutions and to draw up action plans to respond. For over 50 years, we worked on many projects, partnering with various organisations including:

- Heartbeat International Trinidad & Tobago (HBITT) - Pacemaker Implants;
- Regional Distribution Centre (RDC) - Pacemaker Distribution locally and internationally;
- Gift of Life to provide free open-heart surgery to local children in the US;
- Various Government Agencies and Corporate Bodies for disaster relief and other initiatives;
- Diabetes Education Research and Prevention Institute for Pilot Study Programme;
- Joint partnerships with Rotary Clubs in the Caribbean United States, Europe, Canada and United Kingdom;
- Ending polio — Partnering with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the World Health Organization, and UNICEF to end polio, once and for all.
