Subject: MLGCC COVID 19 update

Members.

At a press conference held on Saturday, the Prime Minister outlined a number of adjustments to the Covid 19 Mitigation Protocols which have bearing on the activities of the Golf Club and which come into effect from today, Monday August 17. Fortunately, golf, being a non contact sport, have allowed us to stay open but according to the regulation #143 released on August 16 2020, section 3 (b) "operation of a club as defined in section 2 of the Registration of Club Act" we have to revert to certain protocols which were in place previously.

Please see below for your urgent attention:

## **GOLF CARTS**

Starting today, Monday August 17, carts will revert to single riders only.

Carts will be available on a first come, first served basis. At no time will carts be reserved.

All members using motorised carts must sign the cart agreement before usage.

Other players from the group without cart privileges are not allowed to place their bags or ride on the cart (Please note that if this rule is not adhered to, the cart will be returned to the clubhouse with immediate effect without refund). Subsequent violations of the rules will result in cart privileges of members being suspended.

## All carts must be returned to the Clubhouse no later than 6:15 PM for proper sanitising.

After use, please park the carts facing east close to the large garbage disposals and remove all items from the cart.

Carts will be sanitised after every use but we also encourage players to use their own sanitisers.

Golf Marshals are authorised to ensure that these guidelines are followed.

## **Golf Course Policies/Guidelines:**

- Groups must book their tee times at least one day in advance. 1st Tee starts only. Tee times are available at 10 minute intervals from 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM on weekdays and 6:00 AM to 4:30 PM on weekends. Bookings can be made by calling 640-8337 ext 1. Players are limited to one tee time booking per day. If tee time is missed, you must reschedule for another day. Players without a tee time will not be allowed on the course.
- · Players are asked to please call to cancel tee times in advance to ensure that other members can be accommodated.
- · A wash station has been positioned at the entrance to the golf club. Hands **MUST** be washed and temperatures taken before entering this area. Please use the 20 second recommendation.
- · Additional hand sanitizer stations have been added to the main clubhouse area. Please feel free to walk with your own sanitisers as well.
- · Any persons experiencing the known symptoms of Covid 19 are asked to refrain from visiting the golf course at this time.
- The golf course will be open to members and guests from 7:00 AM to 6:15 PM Monday to Friday and from 6:00 AM to 6:15 PM on Saturday and Sunday. **All players must be off the premises by 6:30 PM.**
- · All players must wear masks when entering the clubhouse and pro shop areas. No mask no service.
- · Locker room facilities will be closed.
- · The washroom on the 5<sup>th</sup> hole will be closed.
- · There will be access to the main washrooms in the foyer only. These washrooms will be sanitized several times per day.
- · Pull carts, club and shoe rentals will not be available.
- · Social distancing is of utmost importance. Players must maintain at least 6 ft distance between each other on the golf course. One player on the tee box at a time, other members of the group must be at a safe distance away from the tee box and from each other.
- · Sharing of equipment is prohibited at this time.
- · Handle your ball only.
- · Bunker rakes will be removed. Players are allowed to place their balls in the bunker away from unraked areas not nearer to the hole. Players are asked to use their club or shoes to smooth the bunker as best as possible.
- · Green cups will be left with the foam insert to allow for easy removal of golf balls. Please do not touch the flags.
- · Ball washers, bins and water coolers will not be available for use.
- · Players must arrive no sooner than 15 minutes before their round and leave no more than 15 minutes after their round. There must be no congregating in the clubhouse, pro shop or car park areas at any time.
- · Practice putting and chipping greens are limited to a maximum of 4 persons at one time and can only be used before your round.
- · Only one person will be allowed in the pro shop at a time for check in and purchases.
- · Scorecards can be submitted via Whatsapp photo to 355-1352 and hard copy can be dropped off in a scorecard drop box located on the outside of the Pro Shop.

Please ensure your name, the date and the tee box played from are clearly marked.

- · Please salute your playing partners with a nod of the head or other non contact acknowledgement after your round.
- Driving range will be available for member use only and will be closed at 6:30 PM. Members are also reminded that the consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited in the carpark, driving range and other immediate environs of the golf club.

Please note that members and guests who do not adhere to the above policies will be asked to leave the golf club and further violations by members will result in a review of membership benefits.

Please help protect your own health and the health our your fellow golfers. Continue to ensure that you play your part to stay safe and aid in keeping the Covid 19 virus from spreading further.
