AREA GOVERNOR JOB DESCRIPTION



Your role as Area Governor is to help clubs succeed and assist the Governor. These are some of your official responsibilities.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Visit each club, either in-person, or via Zoom or keep in touch regularly via phone call, or WhatsApp to discuss club activities, resources, and opportunities.

Establish rapport with club Presidents & support them in setting & achieving their goals, helping to resolve conflicts, and meeting other requirements.

Work with the Clubs in your area to schedule the DG's annual visit to each Club; Serve as a liaison between clubs and district committees.

Assess each club's ability to thrive and mentor club leaders on strategies to help their clubs succeed.

Encourage clubs' involvement in district activities and committees as well as their participation in The Learning Center, Club Central and Brand Center. Assist them with Public Image and Branding questions.

Keep the Deputy Governor and District Governor informed on the progress your clubs make toward their goals, and alert them of any possible challenges.

Stay up-to-date on District and Rotary initiatives by participating in District activities and staying in touch with your fellow Area Governors.

Share the status of clubs with your successor.
