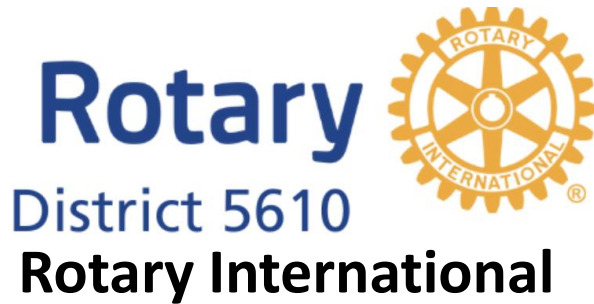

Rotary International and the Rotary Foundation are not the same



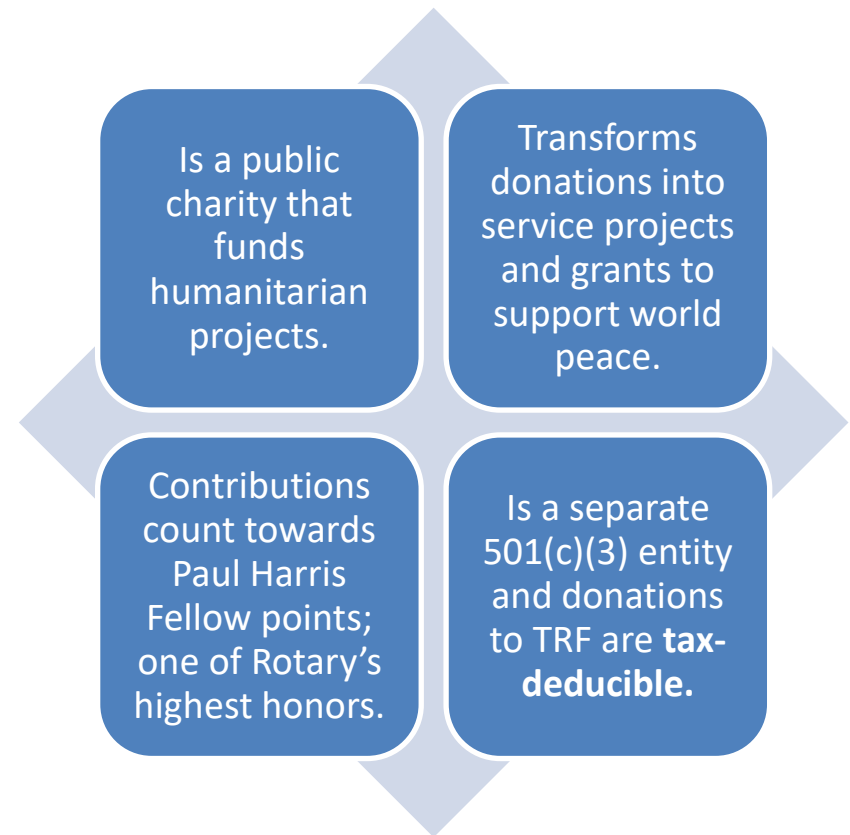
Is a member organization and administrative body that supports clubs worldwide.

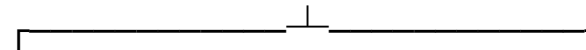


Money Flow Over Time

| (3 years investment period)



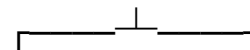
Year 3 Split

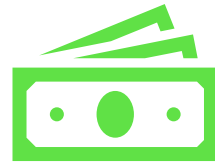

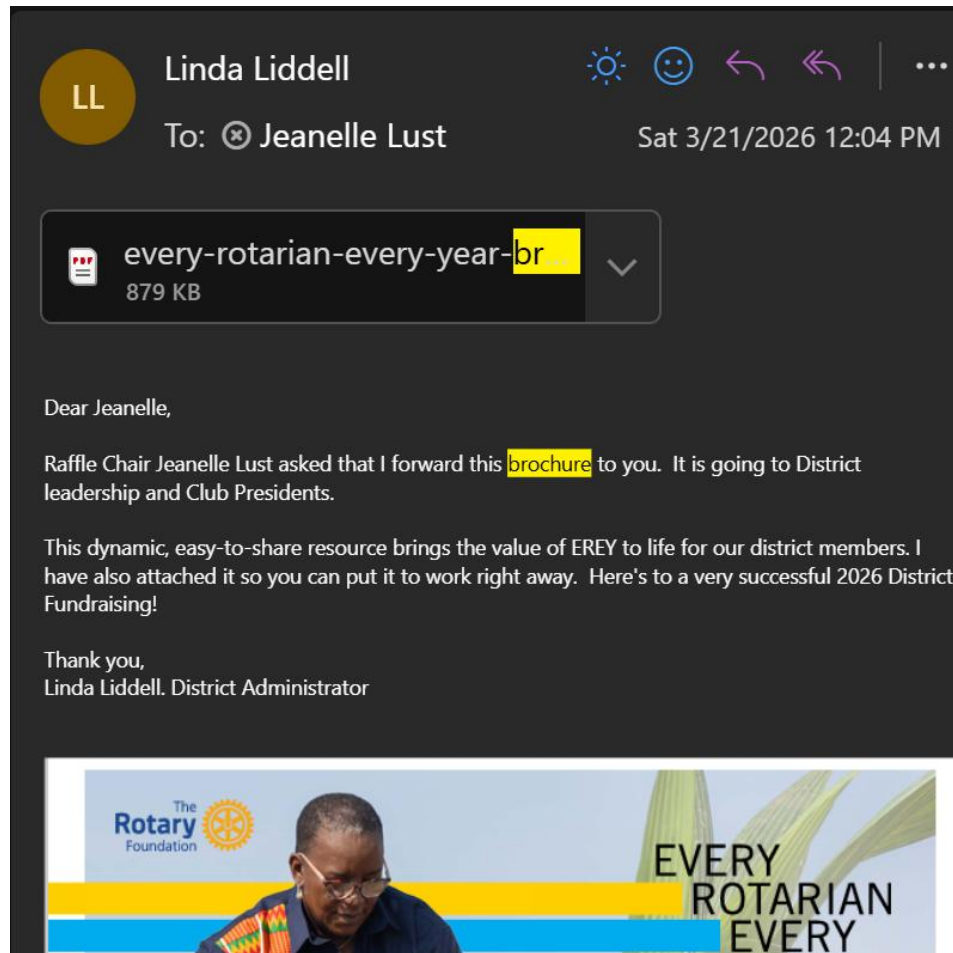
