Matt Michels

PETS Opening Session - Leadership; Thanks for Volunteering

Matt Michels served as South Dakota's 38th Lieutenant Governor from 2011-2019. He served as President of the South Dakota Senate and was South Dakota's first Secretary of Veterans Affairs. Matt was born in Pierre, grew up in Vermillion, and attended the University of South Dakota, where he earned a nursing degree. While working as a nurse, he obtained his Bachelor of Science degree in health services administration, and his juris doctorate. Matt was a commissioned U.S. Naval Officer and was awarded Navy Achievement and Commendation Medals. After his time in the service, Matt and his wife Karen moved to Yankton, SD where she worked as an OB nurse and he joined a law practice specializing in health care and hospital law, along with other aspects of legal services to individuals and nonprofit organizations. Matt holds the distinction of being the longest serving Legislative Presiding Officer in South Dakota history and was the first person to serve two terms as Speaker since the 1950s.

Shirley-Pat Chamberlain, PhD (c), Med, BA Lunch Keynote Session - Why We Build Partnerships

Shirley-Pat Chamberlain will be District Governor of Rotary International District 5040 in 2023-2024. She is an active member of the Rotary Club of Steveston British Columbia and received the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Award in 2012 for outstanding volunteerism. Shirley-Pat is a literacy advocate committed to social action literacy initiatives and community development innovation in rural and remote British Columbia in both indigenous and non-indigenous communities. She brings 20+ years of leadership, community planning and development, fund development, grant writing, project management, facilitation, teaching, and mentorship. Shirley-Pat is of mixed heritage (Tl'esqox na whelh deni heelen (adoptee of Tl'esqox) and is currently a PhD Candidate at the University of Edinburgh.
