Rotary Youth Leadership Award Chair

Background: District 5610 sent 8 students to Rotary Youth Leadership Award camp sponsored by Rotary District 5630. The camp is held for 3-4 days each July at the Nebraska State 4-H Campgrounds. Rotary District 5630 is offering 24 slots to our district for the 2019 camp. At some point District 5610 may entertain offering our own RYLA camp within our district boundaries.

Chair Responsibilities: The District 5610 RYLA Chair will serve as the primary resource for district club officials, prospective campers and prospective camp counselors. The chair will also serve as the 5610 liaison with RYLA 5630 camp officials.

Additional responsibilities will include:

- 1) Encourage RYLA camper alumni to serve as Youth Staff counselors.
- 2) Encourage District 5610 Rotarians to serve as Senior Staff Counselors
- 3) Communicate with 5610 club officials to inform them of RYLA, identify steps to be followed in soliciting student applications and selecting nominees.
- 4) Coordinate the district selection process once district clubs have selected nominees.
- 5) Monitor that all campers selected to attend RYLA complete required health history forms and other required information.

The Rotary Youth Leadership Award Chair will report to the District Governor.
