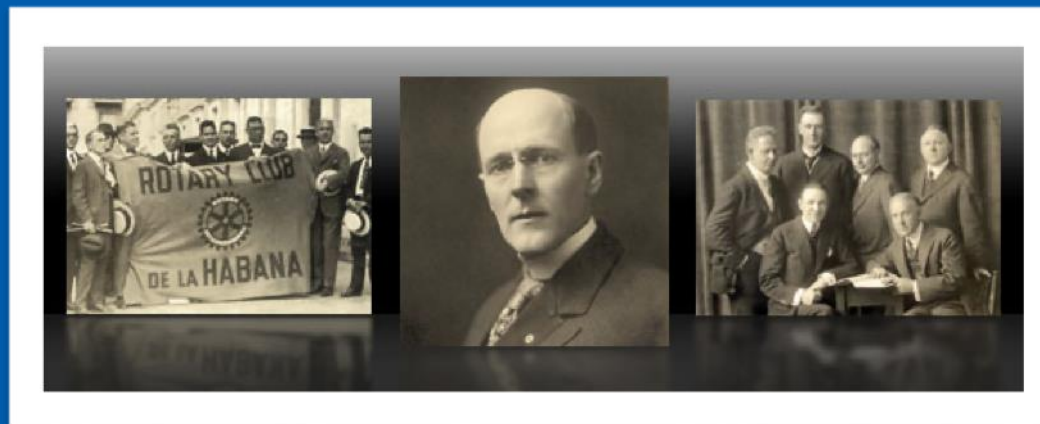

Paul Harris organizes first meeting, which then “rotates” among members’ offices.

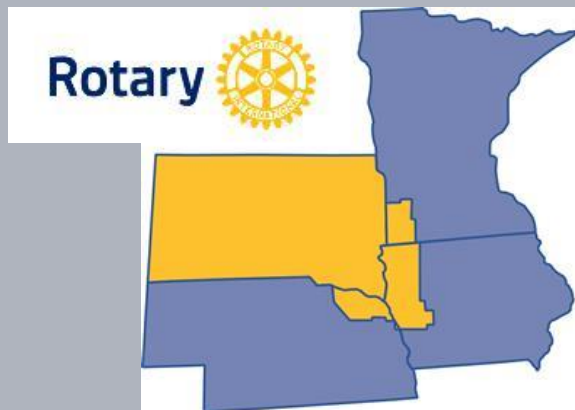
- **1907**

Rotary Club of Chicago provides a public toilet outside City Hall, Rotary’s first community service project.

- **Fourth: Advancing international understanding, goodwill, and peace**



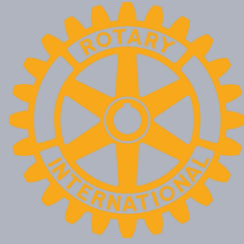


THE FOUR-WAY TEST

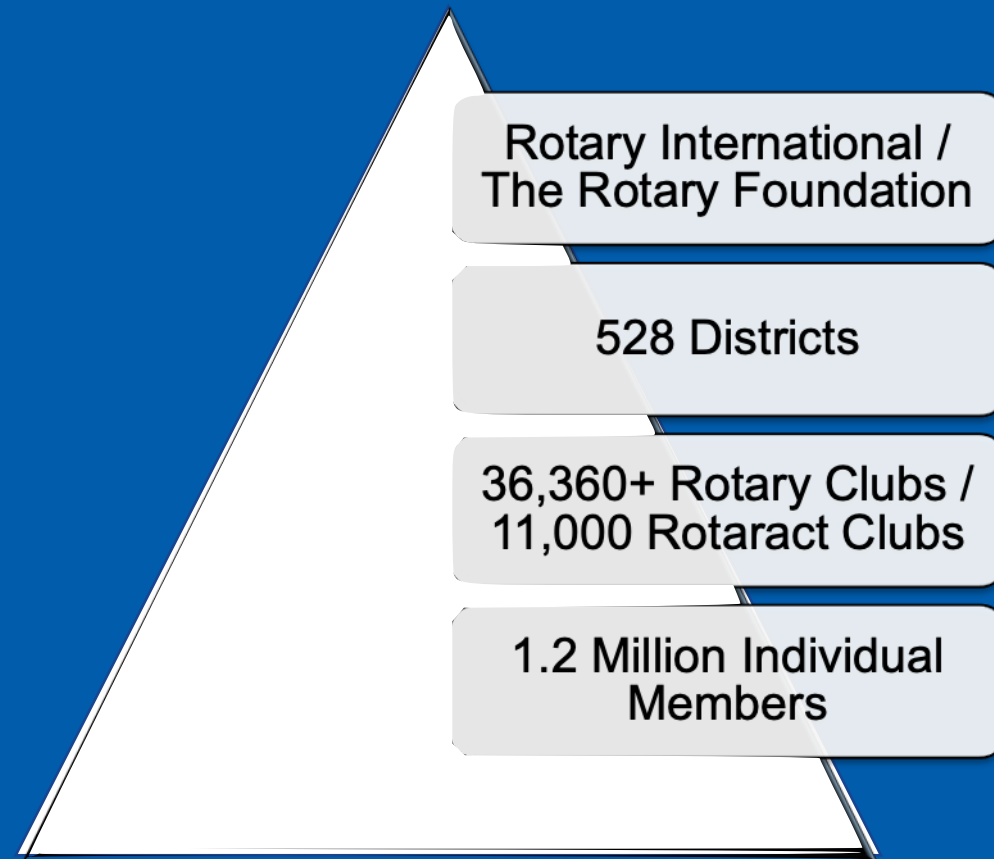

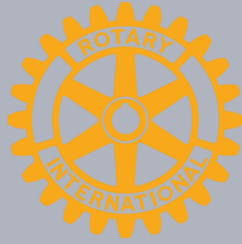


STRUCTURE



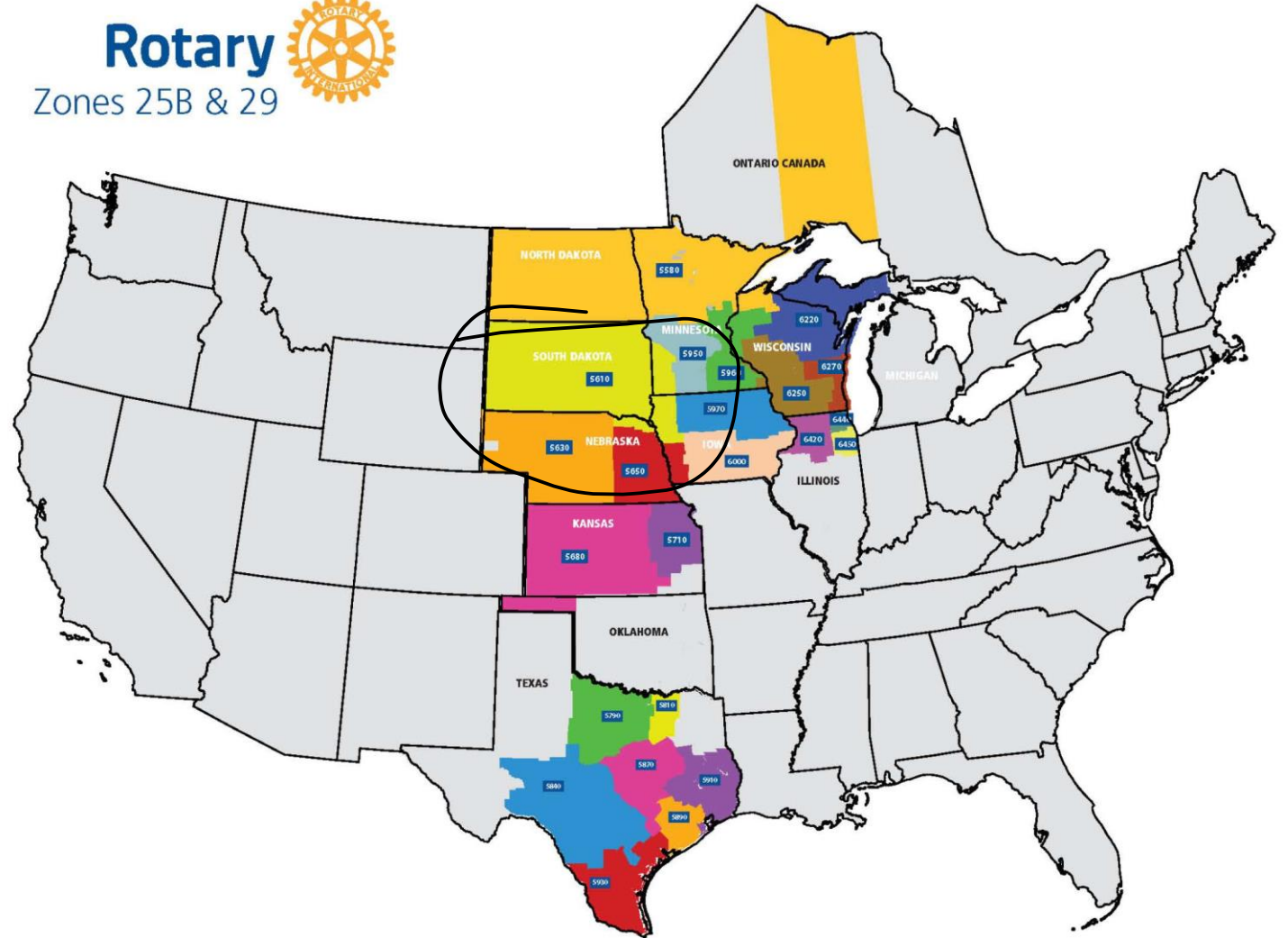
Rotary International is governed by a board of Directors composed of the international president, the president-elect, the general secretary, and 17 zone directors.

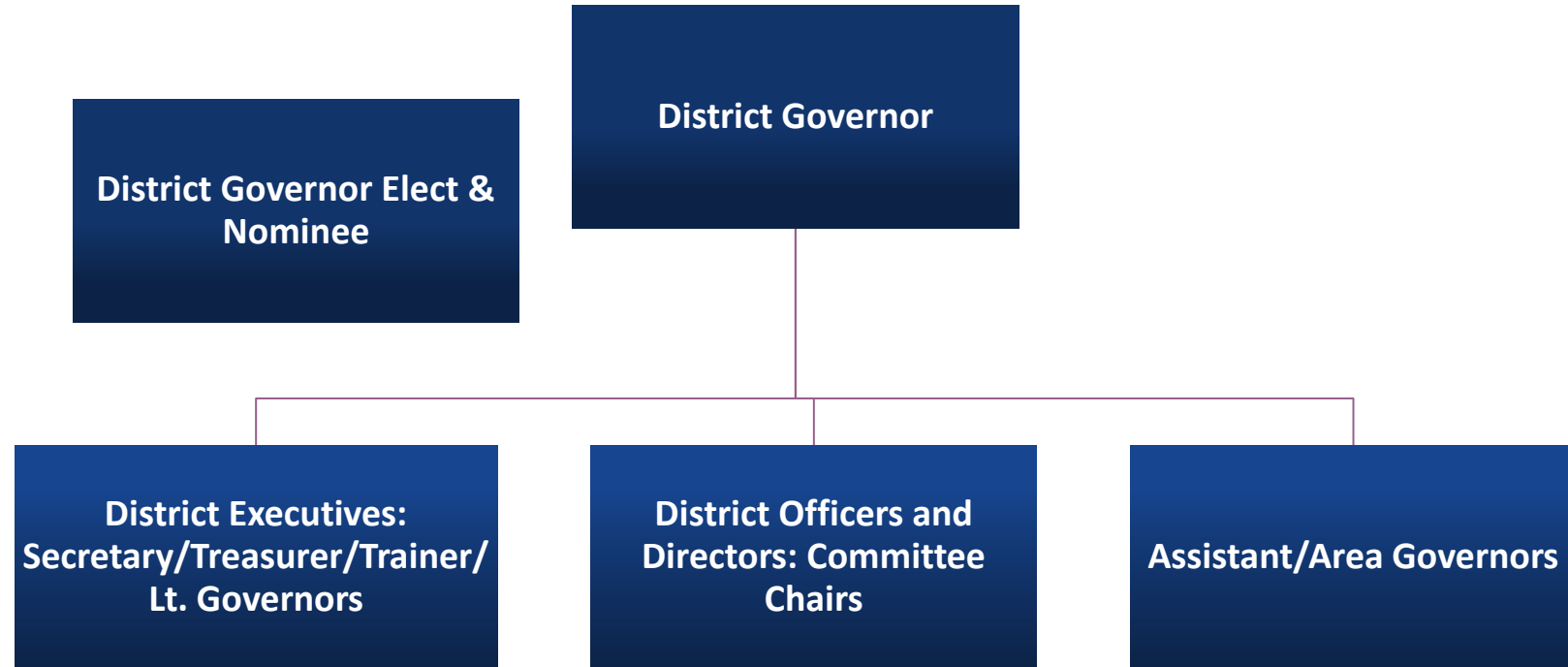
ROTARY AT THE DISTRICT LEVEL



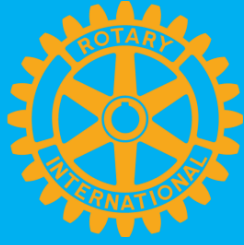

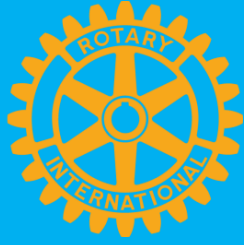

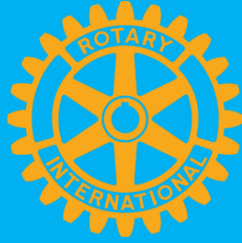
