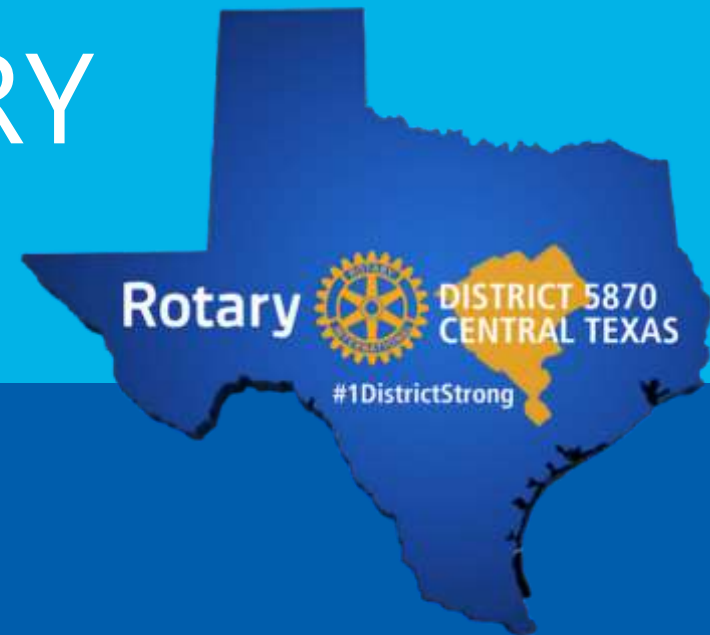

- **1905**

Paul Harris organizes first meeting, which then “rotates” among members’ offices.

- **1907**

Rotary Club of Chicago provides a public toilet outside City Hall, Rotary’s first community service project.

- **1917**

The Rotary Foundation (TRF) was established

OBJECT OF Rotary



- **First: Developing friendships for service**
- **Second: High ethical standards in business and professions**
- **Third: Applying service in each Rotarian's life, business, and community**
- **Fourth: Advancing international understanding, goodwill, and peace**
