## **Todd Smith**

Born in the Washington, DC area to a USAF fighter pilot and an English teacher, Todd Smith and his family moved frequently within the USA and Germany during his childhood. He graduated high school in Virginia before earning his degree from the Eller School of Business at The University of Arizona.

After pursuing a career in public accounting and working in Los Angeles and Saudi Arabia, Todd's career led him to the motion picture industry. During his years at 20th Century Fox and Warner Brothers his responsibility was within production management and finance.
