CAMPER SELECTION - Criteria

- ✓ Articulate
- ✓ Proactive
- ✓ Sound moral character
- ✓ Gets along well with others
- ✓ Flexibility when facing new situations

- ✓ Participate in strenuous physical activity
 - lift 40 lbs
 - jog ¼ mile
- ✓ High Heat & Sun exposure for long periods

MOST IMPORTANT GIRL - BOY Ratio

1 girl : 1 boy



THINGS TO WATCH FOR...

- GPA below 2.5
- Top tier students captain of the football team
- Behavioral or emotional problems
- Social disorders
- Fully participate in camp unlikely
- Disrespect of Authority and / or limits

Goal: Select those campers that will participate and benefit the most



INVEST WISELY

- Interview Selection Process
- Engage Schools Share Criteria / Ask for help
- Communicate Regularly w Campers
 - Before Camp Ensures they Attend
 - Post Camp Return on Investment

IMPORTANT – this is an Award!



COMMUNICATION - COMMUNICATE EARLY AND OFTEN

- Meet Parents
- Communicate regularly
 - Monthly March-May
 - Weekly if necessary, in June
- Transportation
 - Communicate early about your club providing transportation

Stay Connected with your Campers

- Invite them to your club before & after camp
- Club Events and Service Projects
- Have past campers help recruit next year!








