Raise for Rotary provides an easy way for your club to raise funds for **PolioPlus** as part of the **World's Largest Polio Walk**. By creating a club fundraising page, your members, friends, family, and community can securely make online donations while ensuring your club receives fundraising credit.

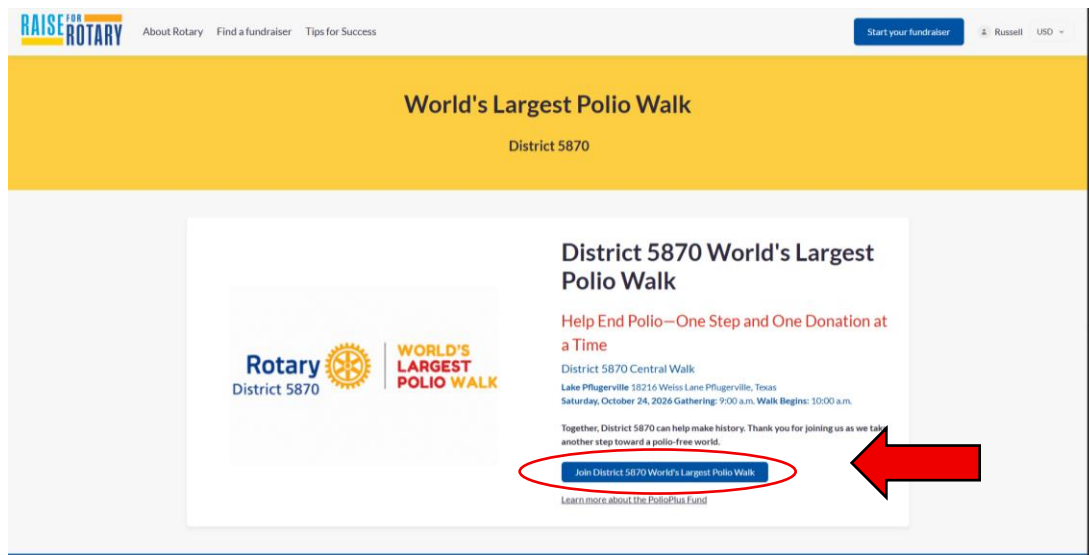
This guide will help you set up your page and answer the most common questions.

Getting Started

Step 1 – Visit the District Team Page

Go to the [District 5870 World's Largest Polio Walk Team Page](#).

Click the blue "Join District 5870 World's Largest Polio Walk" button.



Step 2 – Create Your Club's Page

Follow the prompts to:

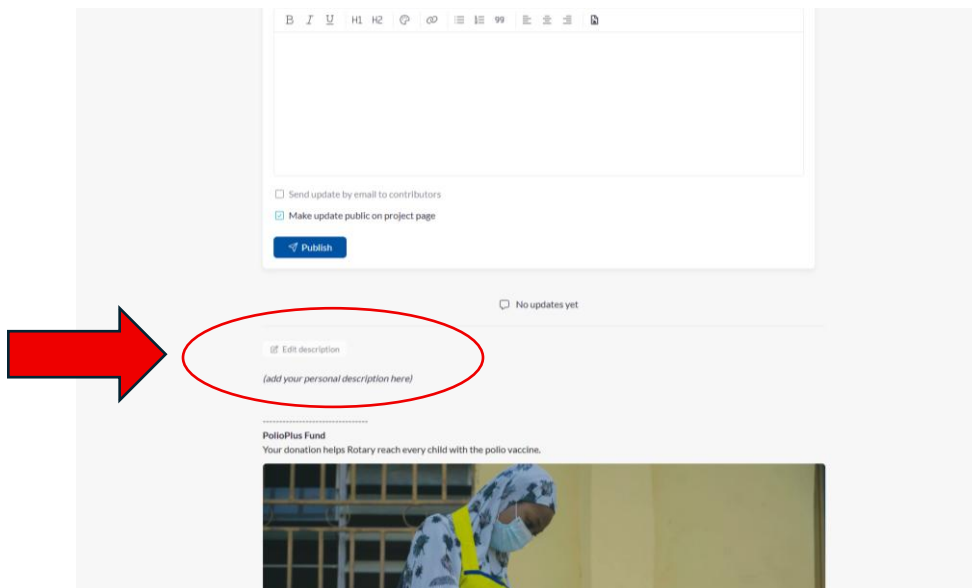
- Create your club fundraising page.
- Enter your club information.
- Customize your page.

Step 3 – Personalize Your Page

Make your page your own by:

- ✓ Adding a brief description of your club's participation.
- ✓ Uploading photos of your club or previous service projects.
- ✓ Adding the location of your walk or event.
- ✓ Sharing why your club supports PolioPlus.

A personalized page is much more likely to receive donations.



Step 4 – Start Sharing

Once your page is complete:

- Email the link to your members.
- Post it on your club's Facebook page.
- Share it on social media.
- Include it in your club newsletter.
- Ask members to share it with friends and family.

Helpful Tips

Request a QR Code

Raise for Rotary can create a QR code that links directly to your fundraising page.

To request one, email: raise@rotary.org

Use the Promotion Resources

Within a few days of creating your page, a Raise for Rotary Coach will send you helpful resources, including:

- Sample emails
- Social media posts
- Fundraising ideas

Encourage Rotarians to Use Their Rotary Email

Rotarians should use the email address associated with their **My Rotary** account when making a donation. This ensures they receive the appropriate donor recognition and credit.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will Rotarians receive donor recognition?

Yes. Rotarians who donate through your fundraising page will receive all applicable Rotary donor recognition.

To ensure proper credit, they should use the **email address associated with their My Rotary** account.

Your club and District 5870 also receive fundraising credit.

Can our club donate through our fundraising page?

Raise for Rotary is designed for **individual donations**. Club donations should be made through **My Rotary** or by mailing a check (U.S. and Canada).

Can members ask friends and family to donate?

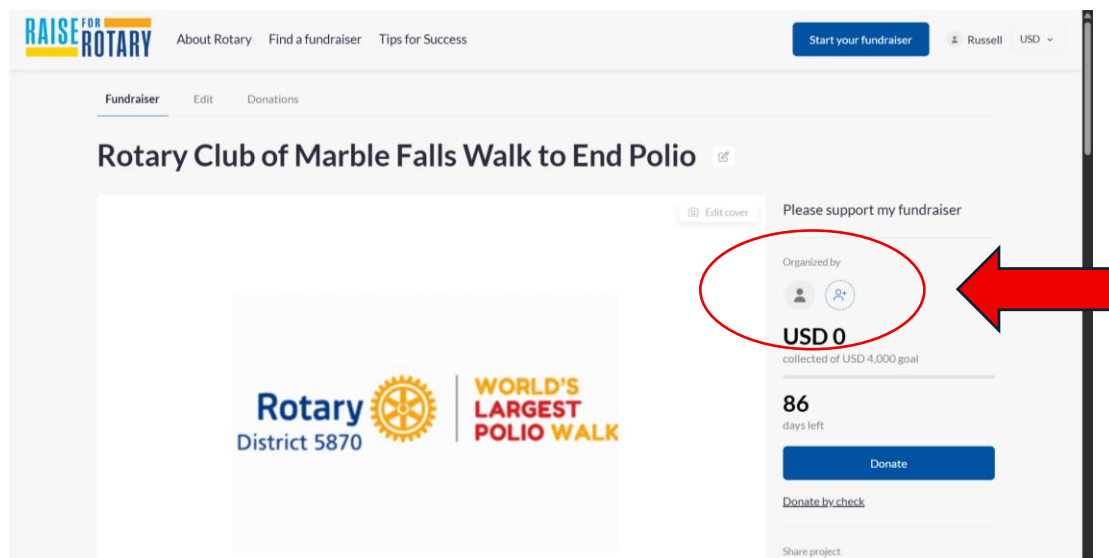
Absolutely! In fact, that's one of the best ways to use Raise for Rotary. Share your fundraising page often and encourage members to invite family, friends, coworkers, and community members to support PolioPlus. The Club receives credit for the donations.

Can someone donate by check?

Yes. Each fundraising page includes instructions for donating by check. A "Donate by Check" form is also included with the resources sent by Raise for Rotary.

Can I add another administrator to our club page?

Yes. On your fundraising page, locate the **person with the "+"** icon under **"Please Support My Fundraiser."** Click the icon and enter the email address of the person you would like to help manage your page.
