- Select your District Trainer Review with District Trainer experiences that you have had to be utilized in your year as District Governor and begin to plan activities leading up to your year as governor and your year as DG.
- Attend District Staff Meetings, Mid-Year Assembly, Mid-Atlantic PETS, Zone Institute, District Conference, District Assembly and District Changeover Dinner.
- Utilize Club Central through the Rotary Website to familiarize yourself with statistics and information regarding your district and clubs.
- Develop a plan to visit each club, unofficially, prior to taking office.
- Begin to develop your financial plan.

Two Years Out: District Governor Nominee

- Start planning your District Conference
- Attend the planning meetings for PETS.
- You will be responsible for planning the Mid-Year Assembly.
- <u>Continue to attend</u>: District Staff Meetings, Zone Institute, District Foundation Dinner, District Conference.
- Begin to keep track of your mileage and travel expense for your District Conference for reimbursement.

One Year Out: District Governor Elect – This will be your busiest year!

- Put together your "Leadership Team" and District Staff
- Prepare a budget for Rotary International
- Formalize your PETS/PrePETS training
- Attend Governor-elect Training Seminar GETS/Zone Institute
- Attend the International Assembly in San Diego in January.
- Attend RI Convention
- You will be responsible for planning the District Assembly
- Prepare your District Budget, District Directory and your District Changeover Dinner
- Schedule your Club visits and District Staff Meetings
- Be prepared to participate in several Club Changeover dinners to install their new officers and Board members.
