KAUAI – THE GARDEN ISLE

- Kauai is known for its tropical climate, waterfalls, scenic Nāpali Coast, and lush vegetation.
- Wailua River State Park's Fern Grotto, a lava rock cave covered in hanging ferns, is accessible only by boat or kayak.
- Waimea Canyon, Hanalei Bay, and Poipu Beach showcase the beauty of the island.

MOLOKAI – THE FRIENDLY ISLE

- Molokai boasts the world's highest sea cliffs.
- The finest beaches include Kawakiu, Kepuhi, and Papohaku.
- The island is full of unspoiled nature for outdoor enthusiasts.

HONOLULU

LANAI – THE PINEAPPLE ISLE

- There is not a single traffic light on the island of Lanai.
- The Manele Golf Course, designed by Jack Nicklaus, is set on cliffs overlooking the sea.
- Off-road vehicles are a popular way to explore the island.

MAUI – THE VALLEY ISLE

- Hawaii's oldest winery, MauiWine, offers tastings of its pineapple wine.

- Iolani Palace, once the home of Hawaiian monarchs, is the only royal palace in the **United States.**
