What was the most impactful Youth Service project completed? (Describe in 200 words or less)

The Kupuna Socials were the most impactful Youth Service projects completed in 2024-25. The RCSH arranged for 3 visits to various elderly programs (residential and adult day care facilities) in Hilo. This group of Rotarians, students from Hawaii Community College, Waiakea HS and Connections PCS had a "social" with the seniors for an hour to 90 minutes of singing, hula, BINGO and arts and crafts. Prior to entering the facility, the Rotarian leader explains the purpose of community service and how simple acts of kindness (smiling, helping the seniors make a lei, folding an Origami crane, playing Bingo together and singing favorite ol' time songs together) can brighten a kupunas day! This social engagement supports emotional, and physical wellness and everyone feels happy and special. There is community bonding between generations. Rotarians modeling and mentoring caring and the aloha spirit creates the Magic of Rotary.

Note: the RCSH supports the efforts with RC of South Hilo and Hilo Bay to bring together students from Hawaii Community College and the UH Hilo to form the EH Roteract Club. Unfortunately, we did not have the 20 students required to charter a club but RCSH members continued to meet with 7-10 students weekly and students
