What was the most successful Foundation campaign completed? (Describe in 200 words or less)

Our Foundation campaign aims to establish a long-term relationship with the Kalihi area community, which is an underserved area on Oahu, and our Rotary Club. Last year, we utilized our District grant to purchase and install a Peace Pole at Kalihi Elementary to encourage peace among the various ethnic groups in the Valley. This year, we addressed the immediate needs of the school by using our District Grant funds to provide clothing for students in case their clothing gets soiled or torn during school hours. The students periodically require temporary replacement clothing throughout the day.

The school provided the clothing sizes, and the items were purchased and delivered to be used in emergency situations. To strengthen connections with the community, the Dole Middle Interact Club assisted in labeling the clothes, making it a joint project.

Upon delivery of the items, Principal John Hamilton expressed appreciation for the support provided to the school.
