What was the most successful Foundation campaign completed? (1000 characters or less) Always asking but in an informative inpiring way. We ask at the meetings and with personal phone calls. We presented to members a large cardboard cut-out "thermometer" which being a visual representation of our club's giving status was easy to understand and inspire members to donate right then and there. We mention our status at every meeting which also "snags" members who may have missed a meeting. We calculated that 68% of our club contributed.
