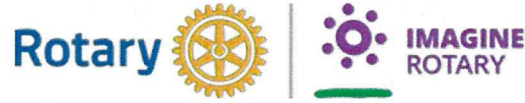

We helped plan, organize and participate in a 4-Club West Side Health and Wellness Fair. We partnered with 33 community organizations to provide information and classes to several hundred participants. This event received substantial media attention, and the West Side Clubs got several new members.

We currently are working with a realty company to do a Maui--wide food drive for the Maui Food Bank. This should involve all 9 Maui Rotary Clubs, and is in honor of Mark Harbison, who was a Board member of the Food Bank for many years.

Our club has done beach clean-ups, with our Rotary Banner; another food drive with a table and our banner; done garden maintenance at Lokelani Intermediate School.

Our signature project is Rescue Tubes on all South Maui beaches, which have GPS locators and have our name and logo on them. Due to the storms we have had substantial maintenance for these tubes. They are used several times per year for ocean resues.

Held on the grounds of the Lahaina United Methodist Church participants had the opportunity to visit 28 health and wellness informational booths. Entertainment was provided by the Lahainaluna High School Band and Uncle George Kahumoku, Jr. Dee's Poi Mochi and Joy's Onolicious Grindz food trucks offered food treats. Water on this warm day was provided by 5A Rent and Space and Tropic Water. The Rotary clubs provided all participants with a reusable water bottle. A unique feature was the Passport whereby participants visited the booths and secured stamps from 10 of the vendors. When turning in their passports, children were able to win kid-friendly prizes. Adult passports were entered into a drawing for gift cards from local businesses. Five members of our club planned for 5 months to organize the event.
