For the 4th year the Kihei Elementary School Student Council and Dolphin Ambassadors EarlyAct Group, consisting of representatives from all grade levels, joined forces with the Rotary Club of Lahaina Sunset for the fourth Pennies for Polio Drive. Led by staff members Bianca Datiles and Joanne Laird, the students were introduced to Rotary International's "End Polio Now Campaign". Student Council and Ambassadors made posters for all classrooms and hallways and provided collection jars that were delivered to each classroom teacher on Friday February 3rd.. The drive ran for 10 days and at the conclusion the Rotary members took the collection jars to American Savings Bank who counted and provided amounts for each of the 36 classes. The results exceed any of the expectations: \$2459.37! Two winning classes will receive a Jamba Juice/Healthy Snack party. ¼ will be allocated to the Student Council for future projects, ¾ will be send to the End Polio Now campaign.
