What was the most successful membership campaign completed? Why should your club be recognized as a Club of Excellence in Membership? (Describe in 200 words or less)

A healthy club is a club that is growing and changing. Growth in membership is necessary to allow RCMS to identify and schedule community service projects, in line with RI's 7 areas of focus. Change is also necessary. Too often the senior core members will reiterate, "that's how it was done in the past". We need to change our thinking, and recruit younger members with "Millennial" mind sets.

Interviews and orientations with a 2-person team was key to recognizing quality perspective members. Sharing Rotary with a club-made binder, assisted in the educational process.

RCMS started the Rotary year with 15 members; interviewed and inducted 6 new members. However, our net gain was 4, due to a member relocating to the mainland, and another entering the workforce. RCMS will end the year with 19 members, a 27% increase, year over year. In addition, 5 of 6 new members, are under 50, and 3 are Millennial (born after 1981)!

We are encouraged that the younger Rotarians will influence younger prospects to join Rotary. Our goal is to recruit Millennial-aged Rotarians with technology knowledge, enhancing our opportunity to become a vibrant club, once again.
