What is the most impactful Youth Service project completed? Why should your club be recognized as a Club of Excellence in Youth Service? (Describe in 200 words or less)

RC Windward Oahu has its very own Windward Rotary Education Foundation (WREF) that annually provides a four-year grant (for 4 year college tuition) of \$20,000 (\$5,000 each year) to excellent and promising students on the Windward side. There is also an annual, one-time grant of \$1,000 for a student who attends a two year college like Windward Community College, or the committee decides the student represents the Ross Mickey Award criteria. To date, \$222,322 + has been awarded to 26 students.
