Prior, average age of members was over 74, and majority of the members are retired. Interviews and orientations with a 2-person committee was key to recognizing quality prospectives. Our hope is that the younger Rotarians will influence younger prospects with technology knowledge thus enhancing our opportunity to become a vibrant club again.
