This past year our club selected Mr. Ken Miyasato for his role in the Karate Club at Kahauiki Village. The residents of Kahauiki Village are from low-income families and some of the students are missing a strong father figure, Ken has helped to fill that void. As part of our vocational service program, Ken gave a presentation in July on the Karate Club. His mission was for students to learn discipline, develop self-esteem and community pride. He shared that several students earned awards as a result of the program. Ken teaches twice week in addition to his regular full-time job. The Karate Club has grown to more than 25 students. He is an inspiration to his students as well as other school instructors. Other teachers at tournaments have mentioned that Ken's students are well behaved and their behavior is a testament to his leadership and guidance.
