When we asked the Director Greg Payton what the center needed, he said cleaning supplies. They were elated when we dropped off a variety of cleaning products to help keep their facility clean. Rotary HPH recognizes the importance of these services and are a proud supporter of their mission.

Our club's passion for ending polio in the world was demonstrated by participating in Purple Pinkie for PolioPlus Challenge. We FUN-raised over \$1250 from donations and by selling over 50 handmade quartz bracelets. For the second year, we were instrumental in securing a speaker from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation to participate in D5000's World Wide Polio Day celebration. This year's speaker was Tehniyat Khan, a Program Officer with the Gates Foundation. Our club's commitment and contribution to PolioPlus include exceeding District's goal of \$1500 per club by 109% and our club's goal of \$650 by 253% with \$1642 in donations. For TRF, we are at \$2324 exceeding our club's goal of \$1750 by 133%. We have already qualified as an EREY club this year and consistently been an EREY club for 20 of our 27 years of existence. We are a 100% Foundation club, have 4 members in the PolioPlus Society and 1 Major Donor.
