We have multiple projects that are impactful:

1. Imua Reading coaching program for first graders behind in reading. We have done this for 7 years, and all children completing the program read above grade level at the end. Life long impact.
2. We maintain rescue tubes and reef safe sunscreen on all South Maui beaches. These are used 6 10 times a year, saving lives.
3. We participated in replanting trees lost in the wildfires; partner with community organizations supplying home supplies for displaced fire survivors; provided school supplies at an elementary school with 60% disadvantaged children.

The North Shore Weather relief Project addressed an urgent community need following severe weather impacts affecting local families. Rotary HPH responded quickly providing \$1200 in direct financial assistance through 24 \$50 gift cards, allowing families to prioritize their most immediate needs with dignity and flexibility. Recipients were identified through trusted community relationships, ensuring aid was both targeted and impactful.
