Our strategy focused on experience-driven recruitment and intentional follow-up. Fellowship events like our bowling Night brought together 35 participants - including members, families and prospective Rotarians - creating an accessible entry point into Rotary. Guests were not simply invited - they were integrated into service projects and meetings, allowing them to experience Rotary's value firsthand. As a result the club strengthened its recruitment pipeline while also improving member engagement and retention. What makes the approach effective and replicable is its simplicity. Focus on belonging before commitment, provide hands-on exposure to service, and reinforce connections through intentional follow-up.
