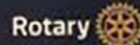

ROTARY DISTRICT 5000 - ENDOWMENT FUND GRANT APPLICATION

Background:

Annually, the Endowment Fund of The Rotary Foundation returns spendable earnings to Districts in the form of District Designated Funds (DDF) from Endowment Gifts marked SHARE. The Endowment Fund accepts donations, in various forms, including cash and testamentary gifts (Benefactor and Bequest Society programs). Those commitments when received are then invested and a portion, termed “spendable earnings,” are then remitted to foundation programs. Earnings not spent are reinvested to grow the Endowment Fund and pay for fund management.

This Rotary Year there will be three grants awarded, each for \$2,000.00.

Grant Goals:

1. Highlight the Endowment Fund of The Rotary Foundation to increase the number of Named Endowed Funds, Benefactor and Bequest Society members
2. Provide funding for enhanced Community/Youth Service project impact
3. Increase Rotary’s Community/Youth Service visibility

Based on the above goals the following will be considered:

1. Expand Reach – How does your Rotary Club translate the project to increased numbers of Named Endowed Funds, Benefactors and Bequest Society Members?
2. Selected projects must be new, not on-going, or previously planned, with measurable outcomes.
3. Selected projects must engage Rotarians in active participation beyond planning or additional funding. Project may be in partnership with other Rotary Clubs or another community/youth organization. Please explain why the project is needed.
4. Tell us how you are going to highlight the Endowment Fund as the source of funding and how you are going publicize your good work.
5. Selected projects must not directly or indirectly benefit any Rotary Club, Rotarian, or Rotarian’s family.

Applications should be submitted no later than midnight November 10, 2021 by email to grants@rotaryD5000.org. The winning applications will be announced by DG Sandy Matsui on or before November 30, 2021.
