In India, glaucoma is the leading cause of irreversible blindness, with 12 million affected and nearly 1.2 million cases of blindness. More than 90% of glaucoma cases remain undiagnosed. Furthermore, the prevalence of glaucoma is steadily increasing due to population increase and the aging of the population.

Retina and Corneal diseases are two other major causes for the prevailing eye problems in developing countries like us. According to WHO, corneal diseases are among the major causes of vision loss and blindness in world today after glaucoma and cataract. In India, it is estimated that there are approximately 6.8 million people who have vision less than 6/60 in at least one eye due to corneal diseases; of these, about a million have bilateral involvement. According to this estimate there is addition of 25,000-30,000 corneal blindness cases every year in the country.

Talking about Retinal Disease which are the most common cause of childhood blindness worldwide. Vitreoretinal diseases as a group are one of the more common ocular morbidities leading to blindness in the adult population.
