The world is on the verge of eliminating one of the most dreaded disease of the 20<sup>th</sup> century - poliomyelitis. During the first half of the 30<sup>th</sup> century, polio crippled over a mission people every year. Even today children in some developing countries continue to fall victim to the disease. But thanks to Rotary International and the 1.2 million Rotary members worldwide, the disease will soon be all but a memory




In 1988 there were 350,000 cases of polio in 125 countries every year. Great progress has been made since then. Today, polio cases have been reduced by 99.9% to 2 cases in 2021 – one in Pakistan and one in Afghanistan.

Since 1985, Rotarians around the world have contributed nearly US\$2.2 billion to help immunize more than 2.5 billion children against polio and have helped secure billions of dollars from donor governments worldwide. And, with World Polio Day approaching, Rotary is ramping up its advocacy work in the 200 countries and regions where Rotary Clubs exist to encourage every national government to commit to the funding levels needed to close the gap.

With Polio nearly eradicated, we must sustain this progress and continue to reach every child with the polio vaccine. Without full funding and commitment, this paralyzing disease could return to polio-free countries, putting all children everywhere at risk. This year, Rotary is again committed to raising US\$50 Million each year to support global polio eradication efforts. The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation has pledged to match that 2-to-1, for a total yearly contribution of \$150 Million.
