CONFERENCE REGISTRATION





It's time to "Rise and Shine with District Nine!" The 66th annual District Nine Conference is scheduled to begin at noon April 29 and end May 1 at noon at the Sheraton Austin Georgetown Hotel and Convention Center.

Conference registration is open until March 31, and cost is \$295 if paid on or before March 31 (conference fee \$40 and meals \$255 = \$295). Late registration fee (April 1 and after) is \$325. Room registration at the hotel needs to be done prior to March 31 and room rate is \$139/night when you select "District Nine". Reserve your room as soon asap as they go quickly.
