



## District 5970 Rotary Club Excellence Award

The District Rotary Club Excellence Award is presented each year to those clubs that have participated in significant Rotary activities throughout the year and have been excellent examples of Rotary’s definition of “Service Above Self”.

All Activities Must be completed by April 1st except as noted below. The award will be presented to Clubs at the annual District Conference.

### Mandatory Activities

- Appoint a Foundation Chair by October 31, 2018 and report same on Rotary Club Central.
- Select an incoming President By December 31, 2018 and report same on Rotary Club Central.
- Complete Membership and Foundation Giving Club Goals on Rotary Club Central by September 30, 2018.
- File Form 990 with the Internal Revenue Service by the deadline of November 15, 2018-OR start process to reinstate if tax exempt status has been lost.

### Complete Four of the Following Activities in the District.

Activity	Done
“Boost” Facebook posts at least 4 times by April 1, 2019.	
Club President follow Rotary District 5970 on Facebook and post one Club Activity on the site	
Host or Sponsor an Exchange Student.	
Sponsor a student for RYLA or YRYLA.	
Apply for or participate in a District Grants	
Apply for or participate in an Global Grant.	
Hold a Polio Plus Event in your community. Preferably during October	
Every Club member makes a contribution to the Foundation	
Increase number of Paul Harris Fellows by 10% over June 30, 2018 number	
Have at least one member serve on a District Committee	
Have at least 1 member registered for the District Conference	
Have at least 2 members attend a District Training Activity-i.e One Rotary Summit, District Conf.	
Have at least one member attend Grant Training	
Have at least one member volunteer for RYLA or YRYLA week.	
Contribute to Polio Plus as a Club	
Have president-elect attend PETS
