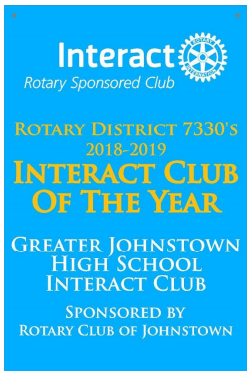

INTERACT NEWSLETTER—District Conference Wrap-up



Interact Clubs from across District 7330 gathered on Saturday, May 4 at the last District Conference for District 7330 to celebrate a year of accomplishments. The highlight of the event was the naming of the Greater Johnstown High School Interact Club as the Interact Club of the Year in District 7330. Five other Clubs were named “Outstanding Interact Clubs” and they were: Somerset Area

High School Interact Club; Greensburg Salem High School Interact Club; Peters Township High School Interact Club; Franklin Regional High School Interact Club and Ligonier Valley High School Interact Club.

Accomplishments by the District Interact Clubs included the collection of 9,748 Christmas cards for veterans in VA Medical Centers in Southwestern Pennsylvania, the collection of 7,770 items of non-perishable food that were donated to local emergency food pantries as a District-wide project, \$6,400 was donated to the District’s Solar Suitcase Project and \$1,624 was donated to Rotary’s End Polio Now project, in total Interact donated more and \$8,024 to the Rotary Foundation this Rotary Year.

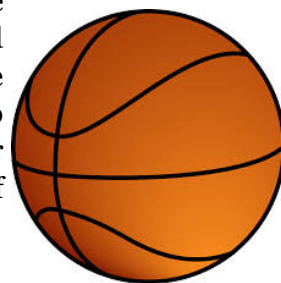


The Ligonier Interact Club just finished up with collections for the emergency food pantries in our area. We
