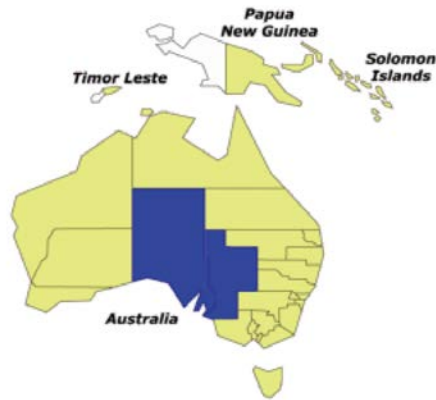


## **RAWCS CENTRAL REGION**

**Some examples -**

**Rotary Club of West Torrens** District 9500 supported Volunteers from: **Nazareth College, Adelaide** who refurbished the village school, assisted in education and vocational training, & provided assistance and training in sustainable agricultural industry, ESL and sports coaching in Triloka village, Baucau, Timor Leste.

**Another example** is the contribution made by the **Rotary Club of Eastwood** in organizing the successful chartering of the **first Rotary Club of the Maldives**.



Through their newly chartered Rotary Club, the first active service club to be established in the **Maldives**, members are keen to be involved in helping with projects to improve the lives and health of everyone in their home country.

Working closely with these local Rotarians, the Rotary Club of Eastwood has now undertaken to **provide sufficient clean drinking water for all communities** in the Maldives.
