Headquarters Building Update

As of July 31, 2014, the former headquarters building in Overland Park, Kansas, has been leased to the Monogram Shop, which previously leased space nearby the headquarters building in Overland Park. Since delegates to the 2014 International Convention voted to pursue the sale of the building, our new tenant has been given a right of first refusal, which means that the tenant has the option to purchase the building for a predetermined price prior to it being available for purchase by any other party. We understand from the tenant that she does, indeed, plan to purchase the building, and we anticipate closing on the sale in approximately December or January.

With regard to the bricks, Executive Director Tracy is in discussion with Cosmo Park in Columbia, Missouri, about transferring the bricks to that location. Delegates to the 2014 International Convention were shown an artist's rendering of one possible area where the bricks may be placed. The bricks will be taken up from the former headquarters property in the coming weeks and will be stored by Cosmopolitan until a plan is worked out for their permanent placement. We anticipate that the buya-brick program will resume in the future, although specific details of the program also are being worked out currently. As an alternative to having bricks placed at Cosmo Park, Cosmos who purchased bricks in the past will be given the opportunity to have their brick(s) mailed back to them at their cost if they choose not to have their brick(s) placed at Cosmo Park. More information will be forthcoming as details are finalized.
