You can help with the sale on Friday, August 13, at the Wyoming Hereford Ranch, at 5:30 pm, sale at 7pm. We need help with getting animals in and out of the sale ring, photo taking, clerking, buying animals for the Kiwanis shares program, and some set up earlier in the day and some clean up afterwards. You can also participate in the Kiwanis shares program, where we pool our money to push the lower priced animals higher. The animals are then donated to LCCC to be used in their livestock education program. Shares will not exceed \$15 a piece and you can sign up at one of the weekly meetings before the sale.

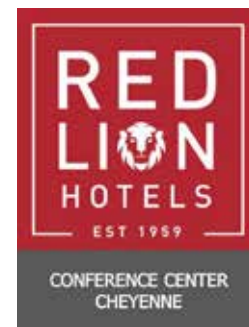
