It became apparent some years ago a number of the Kiwanis grill trailers were showing their age. Some are fifty plus years old. Repair is difficult at best, and impossible at worst. The stove tenders have done a very good job patching and repairing as possible. The untimely death of former Club President Mike Dowling, and the suggestion he be honored by the Club in some fashion, resulted in a proposal, which was approved by the Club Board, to "purchase" a new grill trailer.

Many Kiwanis members, as well as the Dowling Family, donated funds with the designation they be used for the trailer. Those funds, along with funds raised at a Thankful Thursday, as well as a contribution by Cheyenne Frontier Days, thus became the Dowling Trailer Fund. The Club also agreed to set aside funds from the Club "General Equipment Replacement" fund for the trailer.

The donations, as well as the work by the Kiwanis Club stove tenders, has resulted in two trailers, each with eight (8) propane griddles, designated and plated as Mike 1 and Mike 2.

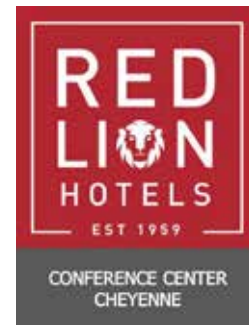
