- (1) There will be three recipients: Needs, LCCC, and Veterans Rock.
- (2) Collections will be at King Soopers, Safeway, the Yellowstone Albertsons, and the I-80 Walmart.
- (3) Flyers will be distributed at the collection sites. The flyers will have a list of suggested donation items. The flyers will also have information about each of the service clubs (recruiting opportunity), as well as information about the recipients and who they serve, and how to send money to them for those who want to make cash donations.
- (4) Shifts should be 2 hours long. We think there should be 2 volunteers at each entrance (three of the stores have 2 entrances; one has 1 entrance). One volunteer at each entrance might be sufficient if necessary. I'll get sign up sheets out after CFD.
- (5) Needs will loan a van and driver; LCCC will do the same. Students from LCCC will be asked to help unload the donations.

Has to have the last word after Jim! Also has her birthday check.

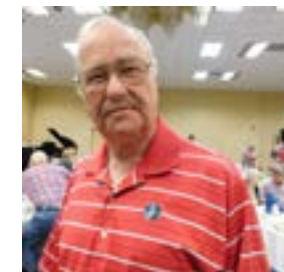

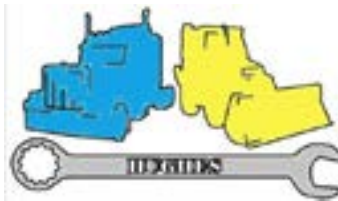
