Pat Ashworth:

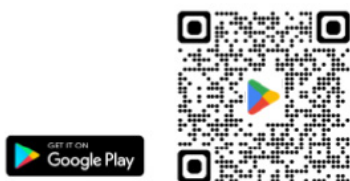
Membership committee will meet right after lunch.

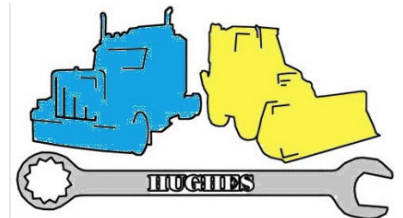
