Glenn then worked as a civilian in the Air Force. Glenn has lived in Indiana, Oklahoma, Arizona, England, France, Southeast Asia, and Missouri. In Missouri he was as Code Vault at Whiteman where he was able to launch a Minuteman Missile. He married Delores while living in Missouri.

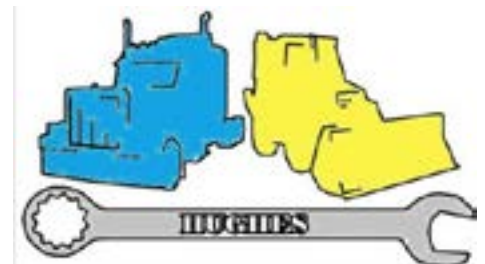
