Alf will be at the 9/16 meeting to give an update on Thankful Thursday and answer any questions.

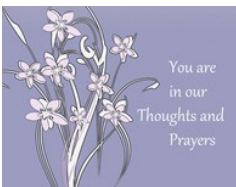
50/50 raffle has started and will continue until November 11. If you want to help sell 50/50 tickets let Robin know

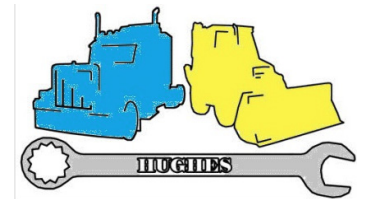
