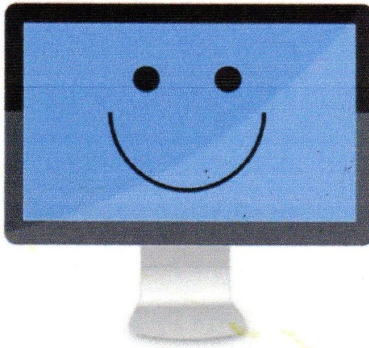

Laptop Donation Drive for area foster kids

The Children's Guardian Fund (CGF) and Sarasota Technology Users Group (STUG) have teamed up to collect used computer laptops. With a long history of recycling and safety, the STUG **sanitizes** the hard drive with a seven-step process that protects the donor's information. The STUG employs software similar to that used by the **U.S. Department of Defense to completely eliminate all data on the hard-drives**. They then refurbish the laptop and install software that is typically required for school. Refurbished laptops are distributed to area students in foster or state care through the CGF and the Guardian ad Litem Program.



Here's How:

Bring your unused laptop to a Kiwanis meeting and Doug Griffin will deliver it to the Sarasota Technology User's Group (STUG) to be refurbished for kids in foster or state care through CGF and GAL programs. **Some details:**

- Both MACs and PCs are welcome.
- Windows XP or more recent please.
- Laptops are best for students.
- Delete any sensitive information or "wipe" the hard drive if you wish. STUG will clean again to industry standards.
- Be sure all power cables and peripherals come with your donation.
- If you have an unneeded WORKING printer you may donate it as well
- If your donation is unsuitable it will be used for parts and/or recycled.
