## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF LEA COUNTY WOMEN'S NETWORK May 20, 2010

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Lea County Women's Network was held on Thursday evening, May 20<sup>th</sup> at 6;30 pm, at the Black Gold Steak House at Zia Race Track.

Meeting was called to order by President, Cortney Whitley at 6:40 pm. Everyone was asked to turn off their cell phones.

Prayer was led by Sharon Clark and the Pledge of Allegiance was lead by Cortney Whitley. Everyone was asked to sign the Sign-In sheet at their table.

The speakers were introduced by Mary Jane Ward: Paula Smith and Debra Hicks with MyPower a new non-profit organization in Hobbs hoping to reduce teen pregnancy, in part by empowering young women to make good decisions and look to the future. Paula showed a power point highlighting the facts. Lea County is #1 in NM and in the country related to teen births. The problem of teen pregnancy has improved in other areas of the state but not in Lea County. Lea County teens have double the rate of STDs of the rest of the state. This is an epidemic that is often unrecognized. The Maddox Foundation is funding a summer camp which will start this year. Debra Hicks talked about the recent graduation ceremony of the first group of girls. Parents were asked about their views of whether or not the program has helped their child. Parent comments were very positive regarding attitude, grades, and behaviors. There are plans to continue contact with these girls throughout their future years in school. Debra also talked about the 3-day, nonresidential, Quantum Learning camp this summer. August 9, 10, and 11 are the dates. The camp will cover 50% life skills and 50% academic skills.

The minutes of the previous month's meeting (April 16) were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the minutes by Sharon Clark and seconded by Charlotte Clark. Motion carried.


