Global Impact STEM Academy is an early-college high school focused on STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) curriculum and has specialized its core gateways to lead our students from the time they begin high school until they enter college or into specialized professional industries that affect our day-to-day lives. While at Global Impact, students encounter interdisciplinary, problem-based learning. The school blends every course together into real-world experiences and assignments that push students beyond the classroom and into a meaningful future.

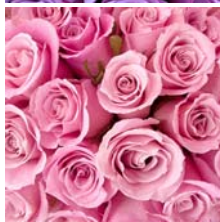
Annual Mother's Day Rose Sale Time Again May 12th and 13th
